Oak Grade Premium

In the Premium grade, the parquet planks are largely free of knots; however, smaller pin knots may occur, adding individuality to the floor. The characteristic medullary rays of oak are also permitted, yet the coloration is quite uniform.





Oak Grade Standard

In the Standard grade, a few small to medium-sized knots may occur, both healthy and filled. The typical medullary ray of oak is also possible. The planks have a natural coloration.





Oak Grade Economy

Planks of the "Economy" grade feature small to large knots, including both healthy and brown filled knots. For the wide country house planks, knots are explicitly incorporated. Cracks are possible and are also filled. The medullary ray is present and clearly visible. These planks are characterized by a colorful play of colors and the typical texture of this type of wood.





Oak Grade Rustic

Planks of the "Rustic" grade contain small to large knots, which are filled with black resin. The wood may have small to large cracks, which are also filled with black resin. Heart cracks as well as raised wind and slate cracks are possible. Slate cracks may occur during later use and do not justify a complaint. The medullary ray is clearly visible. Planks of the "Rustic" grade have a very lively play of colors and convince with their naturally rustic charm, without sapwood.





Oak Grade Classic

Planks of the "Classic" grade present a wide spectrum of knottiness, ranging from calmer to more knotty variants. Characteristic are healthy and brown filled knots, giving the wood a robust and appealing appearance. The natural medullary ray is clearly visible, giving the planks a lively appearance. Overall, these planks are characterized by their lively play of colors and the typical structure of the wood species.
